The Greater Washington DC Chapter of the Organization of Chinese Americans is now accepting applications for the 2007 OCA-DC Scholarship Awards competition. Eligible candidates must be enrolled as a high school junior or senior in the Capital Region and be self-identified as having Asian or Pacific Islander heritage.

Scholarship Goals: To foster creativity, promote self awareness and cultural learning among Asian American students.

Entry Requirements: 1) Create a work of art using recycled materials that represents your cultural identity. Work can be two-dimensional, three-dimensional or performance based, and concept can have multiple levels (individual, family, culture, student, goals, etc.). 2) The weight is no more than 5 pounds or what one person can reasonably carry. 3) Write a reflection of how your artwork represents you. List all recycled products used. 4) Attach this application form to your project.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen based upon aesthetic quality, and use of recycled materials and how they relate the materials to their theme.
